





Charlottetown Corporate Bonspiel

The Charlottetown Corporate Bonspiel is a fund raising event to support curling on Prince Edward Island. The funds raised at this event are destined for capital improvements at the Charlottetown Curling Club and the support of our local curling championship teams. Prince Edward Island has never won the Brier or the Scott Tournament of Hearts since their inception. The event is an opportunity for our business community to get to meet some of our championship curlers and help support the facilities where they practice and compete. The sport of curling is now an Olympic sport. It is also our goal to get a PEI team to the Olympics. Newfoundland did it in 2006, why not PEI in 2010 or 2014. There are efforts to bring the Women's National Championships to Charlottetown in 2011. Help us build the spirit to get PEI's first ever National Women's Championship.

The event will occur on Feb 29th and Mar 1st, 2008. The teams will be made up of 3 company representatives and a skip from one our PEI championship teams. Skips will be selected on Friday night through a special draw. Friday night will also consist of a hot shots competition with each company sending out their representatives for the competition. Their representatives will be one company member and their selected skip.

Saturday will consist of 3 games of 4 ends of curling for each company. Winners will then play a 6 end final. The night is scheduled to end with a 4 or 6 end game between our PEI 2008 Brier and Scott Tournament of Hearts Team. This will be a celebration night for our women's team for 2008 and a send off night for our men's Brier team.

The club will also hold a special Sunday morning learn and play day for kids and employees of every participating companies who would like to learn about curling. This will take place on Feb 10th, 2008.
