## **Coach Standards Policy**

#### **Definitions**

- 1. The following terms have these meanings in this Policy:
  - a) "Association" Curl PEI

#### **Purpose**

- 2. To ensure teams at Curl PEI Championships have trained/certified coaches who meet the minimum standards within this policy.
- 3. To ensure teams at Curl PEI Championships have coaches who have completed the requirements outlined in the Curl PEI Screening Policy.
- 4. To ensure teams at Curl PEI Championships have coaches who aim to provide a safe sport environment.
- 5. To ensure coaches of Provincial winning teams meet the coaching standards for National Championships.

#### Communication

- 6. This Policy will be published upon approval on the Association's website and communicated to all member clubs, including the effective date, via email.
- 7. Amendments to this Policy will be immediately posted on the Association's website and communicated to all member clubs via email.

# **Policy**

- 8. Teams are responsible for naming their own coach.
- 9. Coaches of teams at all Provincial events must be at least 16 years of age.
- 10. In competitions where a coach is mandatory, a coach MUST be listed at the time of registration.
- 11. Coaches coaching at a Curl PEI Championship must comply with Curl PEI's Screening Policy and must complete the Coaching Association of Canada's Safe Sport Training (<a href="https://safesport.coach.ca/">https://safesport.coach.ca/</a>).
- 12. Coaches coaching at a club or recreational level should comply with Curl PEI's Screening Policy and should complete the Coaching Association of Canada's Safe Sport Training (https://safesport.coach.ca/).
- 13. The Coach is directly responsible for the conduct of their team, on and off the ice.
- 14. Any team can add/change their coach after registration by notifying the Curl PEI office.

## **Minimum Training/Certification Requirements for Competitions**

- 15. U13/U16Meet event standards.
  - a) Coach or Guardian is mandatory.
  - b) No training or certification is required.
- 16. U18/Juniors
  - a) Coach is mandatory.
  - b) Provincial Trained Club Coach; Trained Competition Coach; or NCCP Level 1 Certified required.
  - c) National Meet event coaching certification.
- 17. Canada Games
  - a) Coach is mandatory.
  - b) Provincial-Trained Club Coach; Trained Competition Coach; or NCCP Level 1 Certified required.
  - c) Canada Games Meet event standards.
- 18. Women/Men
  - a) Coach is recognized but not required.
  - b) Provincial Trained Club Coach; Trained Competition Coach; or NCCP Level 1 Certified required.
  - c) National -
- 19. Mixed/Mixed Doubles/Seniors/Masters/Stick/Curling Club Championships
  - a) Coach is recognized but not required.
  - b) Provincial Trained Club Coach; Trained Competition Coach; or NCCP Level 1 Certified required.
  - c) National Certified Competition Coach or NCCP Level 2 Certified required.

Once a PEI Champion has been determined, a team may name a new coach if a change is needed for the next level of competition. In the case where a PEI Champion must name a new coach, the team must do so within 24 hours of being named PEI Champion. The Curl PEI Executive Director may appoint a coach for the National Championship if a coach is required and the team has not named an eligible coach.
